

PROJECT SCOPE Student Resident Leader (SRL) 2010 APPLICATION

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

SCOPE is a three week-residential program designed to simulate the college experience. During this period, the students live on campus in the residence hall. Participants take classes to improve their skills in science, computer literacy, psychology and spoken word. They also are provided additional workshops around study skills, library research, career planning, and much more. Social and sports activities, as well as group living, round out the total summer experience.

If you are hired as a Student Resident Leader, you will be required to aid in reaching the objectives of this program. To instill in SCOPE students a positive attitude toward learning and postsecondary education.

To increase students ability to relate to their peer group by development of a sense of personal worth

To expose the students to new academic, social and cultural learning experiences.

To provide remedial help to individual students when necessary.

To help the students increase their understanding of and ability to cope with their environment.

JOB DESCRIPTION

Establish rapport with assigned students, as well as all SCOPE students. Approximately 8-10 students will be assigned to you.

Participate in all activities.

Supervise students on trips and throughout the SCOPE program.

Identify problem areas of students and refer them to SCOPE staff.

Enforce residence hall and program rules consistently.

Know where your students are at all times and be accessible to them.

Attend all SRL general meetings with the Head Resident Leader/Coordinator.

Report any serious infraction regarding drugs, alcohol, or sexual conduct so the Coordinator may begin working with the student involved.

Wake your students in the morning for classes.

Conduct a bed check each night and enforce the "lights out" rule.

Work with SCOPE instructors as tutors for their students.

Work with SCOPE instructors in addressing inappropriate classroom behavior.

Live on campus for the entire 3-week period of SCOPE.

Attend mandatory training/orientation the Friday and Saturday before SCOPE begins.

PROGRAM DATES

Project SCOPE will be held June 6 thru June 25, 2010. Remember, SRL's are required to stay on campus during the 3-week period and **may not hold another job during this time!**

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicants should be college students (at least sophomore status/30+ credit hours) with a grade point average of 2.5 or above on a 4.0 scale. Some experience working with adolescents is preferred but not required. Preference will be given to upper classmen. Applicants must be able to work well with others and possess a genuine commitment to working with young people. All applicants must consent to a background check.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The deadline to submit your application to be an SRL is **Friday April 2, 2010**. ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED WITH AN UNOFFICIAL COLLEGE TRANSCRIPT. Applications without transcripts will not be considered.
